**6.1 Quality of Care Review – B. Smith**

B. Smith reviewed a QRCA (2023-2-5042197011) fall with injury. The outline describes the hospital's conclusions and suggested corrective measures.

At the end of the presentation, B. Smith shared the presentation and summary of the case and evaluated the recommendations.

A 61 year-old female, her chief complaint was chest pain, dysuria, epigastric pain, and fever for several days. She has a history of COPD, thyroid disease, asthma and history of UTI's.

B. Smith advised that there were no recommendations were identified for this case.

1. Patient was seen within 1h15min. by the ED doctor and treatment as follows:
  - Blood work, IV fluids, and antimetic were
  - Cipro was ordered, discharged home within 2h45min.
2. Multiple calls to patient's home next morning to report blood cultures
  - Next of kin was contacted who found the patient deceased at home.
3. Coroner's report:
  - Unofficial diagnosed with ruptured aortic aneurysm (a rare diagnosis); a non-contrast CT is marginally sensitive for gastric aneurysm.
