SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

Performs diagnostic and/or therapeutic ultrasound procedures within the Department of Diagnostic Imaging, working within scope of practice and maintaining patient confidentiality. Is a resource within the department, with specialization in vascular ultrasound, breast imaging and MSK imaging. The Senior Sonographer will assist in prostate biopsies.

The Senior Sonographer will collaborate with radiologists and the department manager in quality improvement, quality assurance, risk management and patient safety activities both departmental and organization wide.

The Senior Sonographer will work closely with the Chief Radiologist (or delegate) regarding using, updating or changing clinical protocols and procedures. They will assist the manager in maintaining ultrasound equipment in safe working order by trouble shooting and summoning the service engineers as necessary. They will organize and schedule preventative maintenance for the ultrasound equipment.

The Senior Sonographer will schedule all sonographers and assist the Charge Technologist with filling of shifts for required coverage, as required.

The Senior Sonographer will be cognizant of budgetary constraints, utilize material resources, supplied and equipment in a safe, cost-effective manner.

- Current Registration in good standing with the College of Medical Radiation Technologists of Ontario (CMRITO)
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Knowledge of computers
