



Diagnostic Imaging (Estimated) Wait Times

As of April 30, 2023

| Test/Procedure | Estimated Wait Time | How are we doing?* |
|---|--------------------------------------|---|
| Elective General Ultrasound | approximately nine (9) weeks | Increase from 1 ½ months |
| Echo (echocardiography) | approximately five (5) weeks | Decrease from three (3) months |
| Diagnostic Mammography | 2 weeks | No change |
| Ontario Breast Screening Program (OBSP) Mammography | approximately 9 weeks | No change for called in requests |
| CT urgent/semi-urgent | No wait time | - |
| Elective CT non contrast | approximately 12 weeks | No change |
| Elective CT with contrast | approximately 14 weeks | Increase from 12 weeks |
| General X-ray | approximately two (2) weeks | Increase from no wait time reported at end of March |
| Bone Mineral Densitometry (BMD) | Wait time information not available. | BMD tests are performed on a limited basis due to staffing issues |

^{*}Due to a (temporary) limited number of booking clerks, there is a delay in scheduling patients that has resulted in an increase in wait times on a short term basis.

Similar to the triage process in the Emergency Department, the Diagnostics Imaging Team (DI Team) receives and reviews all test requests and requisitions to determine level of urgency. **The DI Team always sets aside time to support inpatient and urgent test requests.** If you are concerned about the wait time for your appointment, please contact your primary care provider for more information.
