POSITION SUMMARY:

Reporting to the Manager, Diagnostic Services or designate; the Cardiac Sonographer will: Perform thorough and accurate ultrasound examinations of the heart and supporting structures on outpatients and inpatients, intravenous insertion as required, contrast and bubble studies.

Ensures that optimal imaging quality is obtained, documentation completed and images are sorted on PACs.

Reviewing and discussing findings with the cardiologist (Cardiology support is provided through the cardiologists of Kingston General Hospital).

Other responsibilities as assigned.
