POSITION SUMMARY:

The Speech Language Pathologist, operating within the scope of practice, provides assessment and treatment to children 0-5 years in order to achieve their optimal communication potential. Works autonomously, but in a collaborative and consultative manner with professional staff of other agencies within the Preschool Speech-Language (PSL) System, parents, families, physicians, and other community services as required. Interprets findings and counsels families/caregivers on treatment and outcome of treatments. Prevention activities, education and administration tasks associated with caseload management are also part of the role. Participates in the TQM process as a team member in assessing quality and making recommendations for improvement.

Observes the Code of Ethics of the College of Audiologists and Speech Language Pathologists of Ontario (CASLPO). Follows the mandate and policies of the Provincial PSL.
